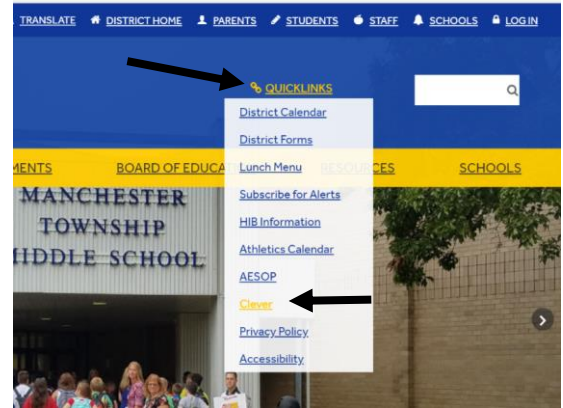


Dear Families,

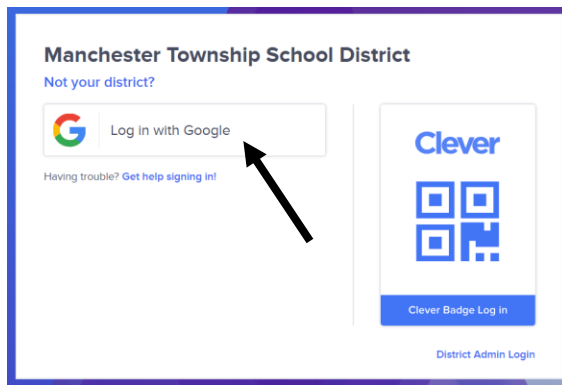

Please be aware that the way to access these MyMath student materials has now changed. Updated directions below provide you with login information.

Access McGraw-Hill My Math online easily!

1. Go to www.manchestertwp.com
2. You will see QuickLinks at the top right of the screen.
3. Hover over QuickLinks and then click Clever
4. You will be prompted to click the “Log in with Google”



link. You child will need to log in with their @mtschools.org google account.

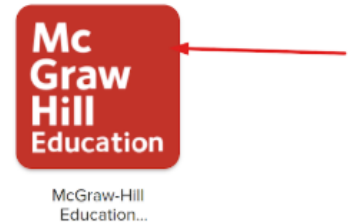


5. Next you will be brought to the Clever App selection screen.

Select the McGraw Hill Education App.

6. This will bring you to a page with a picture of the grade level

Math textbook for your child’s class. Click launch next to the book to launch the Student Center.



Access the following tools to stay connected to your student’s classroom and their math progress:

- **eHelp** assists students by giving targeted help in completing homework.

- **Personal Tutors** are online virtual teachers that walk your student through the steps of the lesson problems. The personal tutor includes lesson examples and narration to describe the thinking process as the problem is solved. The tutors are available for grades 3-5 and can be accessed anytime/ anywhere.

- **Animations, Games, and Tools** allow your student to reinforce the lesson's concepts by watching animations, interacting through games and apps, or exploring with virtual manipulatives.

- **Math at Home Worksheets** provide information and activities to help your student better understand the chapter.
