Here are some recommended databases you can use at home and in class - with your OCL library card. To access these wonderful learning tools, follow these simple steps:

1. Go to www.theoceancountylibrary.org
2. Click "Resources"
3. Click "Databases"
4. Click "Kids" to access 27 different resources
5. Click "View" to open a database
 - a. Try **Brainfuse** for homework help - Click "View" and "Open Database"
 - b. Try **Explora** - Children's (EBSCOhost) for animals, biographies, geography, science and social studies - Click "View" and "Open Database"
 - c. Try **NoveList** Plus K-8 for book recommendations and read-alikes - Click "View" and "Open Database"
 - d. Try **Tumblebooks** - animated picture books and more for free downloadable and read to you electronic books, videos, and games - Click "View" and "Open Database"
 - e. Try **World Book Kids** for videos, animals, maps, educational games, and science projects - Click "View" and "Open Database"
6. Enter your library card number to use the services when prompted
